What is the Incident Notification Management System (INMS)?

The Incident Notification Management System (INMS) is a centralized, web-based platform designed by the National Telecommunications Commission (NTC) to facilitate secure reporting, monitoring, and coordination of cybersecurity and information security incidents.

It provides a unified digital environment where both NTC internal units and external entities (such as government agencies, telecom providers, and partner organizations) can submit, track, and assess incident reports related to cyber events, service disruptions, and data breaches.

Key Objectives:

- Standardize and digitize cybersecurity incident reporting.
- Strengthen coordination between **NTC CERT/CSIRT, Sectoral CERTs, and external organizations.**
- Improve situational awareness and national cybersecurity resilience through structured reporting and data analytics.
